President's Report:

Richard Gardner stated that this would be his second and final year as president. We discussed the need to incite school spirit. Suggestions included:

- Designate each home football game as a different "color" day. We want the students to wear green, gray or black to certain games.
- Put signs out at different locations throughout the community to announce home sporting events
- Have "feeder school" days. Invite the staff and students to sit in a particular section and be recognized during the games.

Procedures instituted:

- All requests for checks for bill payment must be submitted via email to either Richard or Jane.

- Cash pickups from events must be coordinated through Gus or Jane and require a 2 person count prior to hand off. Large upcoming events will be the Football card sales, Coach Gray's cookie sale & Coach Beard's event.
- Concession money will be picked up at the end of the night with a double count.
- Need meeting with Titan Touchdown parents regarding concessions. Varsity games were well staffed with volunteers but JV / Freshmen games needed better coverage.

Treasurer's Report:

- Signers on the accounts will be Richard Gardner, Jane McClughan and Gus White.
- Discussed merchant processing and availability of WIFI access and whether the machine should be bought or leased. Gus will meet with Greg Keller to discuss feasibility. All sports can use machine for large events however the school store will have first right of use.

Committee Report:

Concessions: No one has stepped forward to coordinate concessions. We discussed possibility of hiring someone to coordinate setup and purchasing.

We will be unable to borrow the pretzel machine for the coming year and Laurie Van Bibber has agreed to review selections and make a recommendation. Lois will call Lloyd Gilbert from Gilbert's refrigeration to determine if he has equipment available to purchase since store is closed. Gilbert's is only doing service. Sonya, Laurie and Bruce have keys to the concession closet. We need to reassign them.

School Store: Bridget Keefe discussed the new offerings for the coming year. We will be up and ready for the freshmen orientation on Aug 3 and will be clearing out styles not carrying over to the next year. Richard Gardner approved the purchase of a grid fixture for display @ approx \$150.

Membership: We have 2 new members and 3 renewals so far for the coming year. This year's membership fee is \$15 with an option to designate \$5 of your fee to a sport. We will be providing a bumper sticker & 10% discount on all Spiritwear merchandise in the school store with all paid memberships

Concession Stand: Boosters will maintain the first right of refusal on all events. Junior Titans will have 3 home games this year. We will explore the option of selling Catoctin Kettle Corn at home games.
